
QM3 BLAKE L. O'NEIL - 14 July 54 to 55



I Blake O'Neil was born 23 March 1929 at Roosevelt, Utah. I had reddish blond hair, now gray, and hazel eyes. I enlisted in the Navy at Dallas, Texas on 26 March 1954. Because I had prior military service, four years U. S. Army, I did not attend navy boot camp. I served aboard USS FRANK E. EVANS (DD 754) in the OC Division as a Quartermaster third class. I came on board 14 July 1954 and made the Westpac cruise, which included Formosa patrol, shelling of the Tae Chin Islands, observance of typhoon Pamela, Midway Island and the gooney birds. I broke my leg on the bridge in February 1955 and was transferred to Corona Naval Hospital, California. That was the last I saw of USS FRANK E. EVANS.





HOMER BIGART SENDING FOR NEWYORK HERALD TRIBUNE

ABOARD DESTROYER FRANK E EVANS NOV FOURTH DESTROYERS OF TASK FORCE SEVENTY TWO PATROLLED EAST CHINA SEA OFF TACHEN YESTERDAY AFTER RACING FROM FORMOSA STRAIT TO SUPPORT CHINAT GARRISON OF INVASION THREATENED ARCHIPELAGO

EVANS SUMMONED FROM ITS USUAL PATROL BEAT SPED NORTHWARD TUESDAY NIGHT IN RESPONSE CHINAT APPEALS AFTER SERIES RED AIR

ATTACKS SEEMED PRELUDE LONG EXPECTED INVASION STRATEGIC NORTHERN ANCHOR OFFSHORE ISLAND CHAIN

GRAVITY OF MISSION WAS HEIGHTENED BY COMMUNIST INTRODUCTION AIR POWER IN STRUGGLE FOR ISLANDS. INITIAL RAID MARKED GRIM TURNING POINT ACCENTED NATIONALIST WARNING POCKET WAR MIGHT SPREAD UNLESS UNISTATES PROCLAIMED INTENTION PROTECTING QUEMOY TACHEN

--UNIDENTIFIED SURFACE CRAFT-- MEETING ONE BIG CONCENTRATION OF OVER 100 FISHING JUNKS NORTH OF QUEMOY. BUT MOST INTER-ESTING SKUNK WAS ENCOUNTERED ON FIRST NIGHT OF PATROL MIDWAY THROUGH FORMOSA STRAIT

SKUNKS NAVIGATION LIGHTS SIGHTED 12 MILES OFF PORT BOW

AROUSED EVANS CURIOSITY

CLOSING TO WITHIN 9 MILES EVANS USED FLASHING SIGNAL QUOTE WHO ARE YOU

SKUNK DELIBERATED FIVE MINUTES THEN REPLIED RATHER HAUGHTILY QUOTE HER MAJESTYS WARSHIP CRANE. WHO ARE YOU EVANS BLINKED OUT HER INDENTITY. QUOTED GOOD NIGHT SAID SKUNK

QUOTED HAPPY VOYAGE SAID EVANS.
NEXT DAY EVANS ENCOUNTERED BRITISH MERCHANTMAN EMPIRE ORWELL WHICH CONTINUED NORTHWARD COURSE AFTER REVEALING IDENTITY. EVANS WASNT STOPPING ANYONE. UNISTATES WARSHIPS

ARENT ENGAGED IN BLOCKADE DUTIES
TONIGHT EVANS OTHER WARSHIPS OFFBROKE PATROL TO FLEE
TYPHOON PAMELA NOW TEARING WESTWARD OVER BASHI CHANNEL OFF

SOUTHERN AND FORMOSA ENDIT BIGART.
